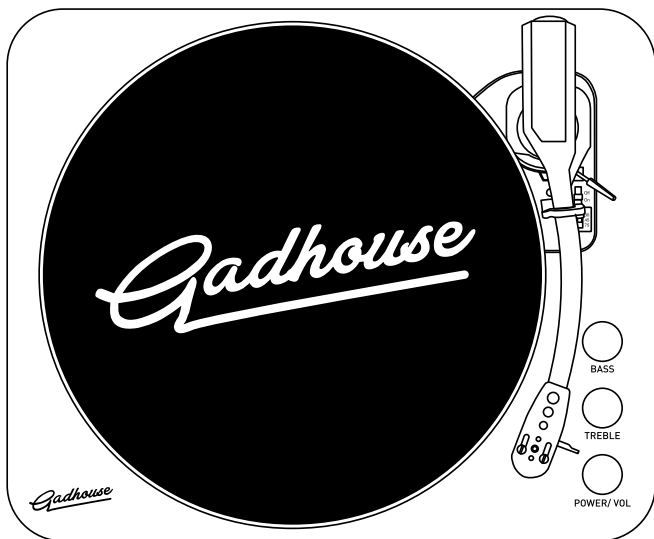

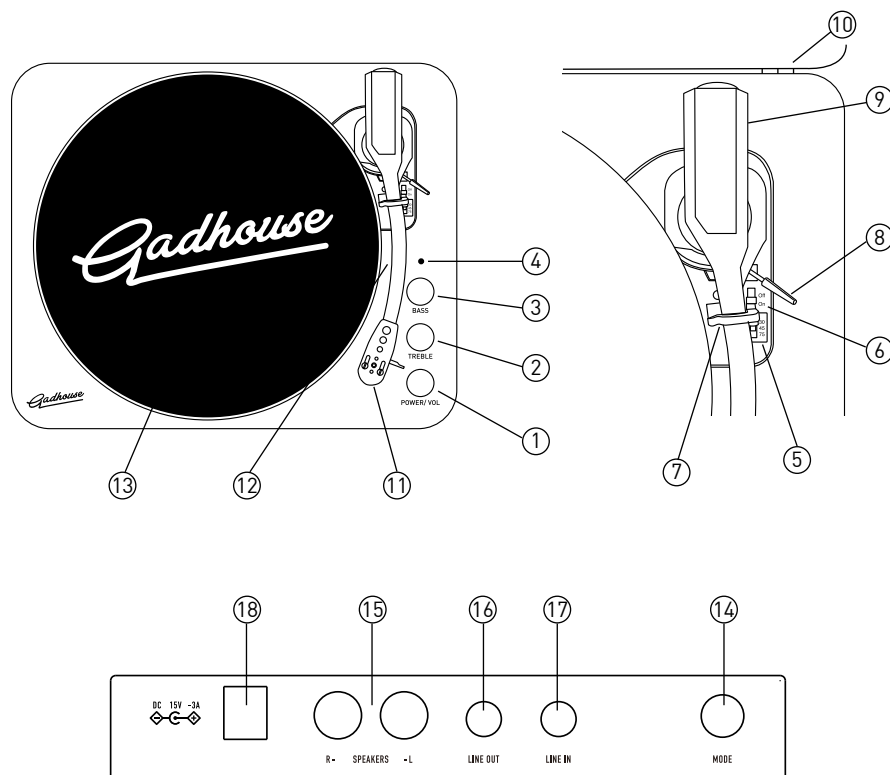

GETTING STARTED

Unpacking and power source

1. Remove packing material from Dean turntable
2. Remove power adaptor from the gift box of Dean turntable
3. Remove tie from adaptor
4. Set the turntable properly on a flat, level surface
5. Open the dust cover (10)
6. Remove black-tie wrap from tone arm holder (7)
7. To begin using the turntable, remove the stylus guard by gently pulling toward yourself from front of needle (11)
8. To continue using the turntable, release tone arm (12) from tone arm holder clip (7) by gently pushing to the right. (However, when finished playing, please lock the tone arm holder by gently pushing to the left and protect needle by inserting the stylus guard)
9. Plug the power adaptor into an appropriate wall outlet
10. Plug the small end of the power adaptor into the power jack (18) on the back of the Dean turntable
11. Let's Dance by turning the Power Control Knob (1) From Left to Right position

OPERATION

AUDIO INPUT

Turntable function (LP)

1. Turn on the power by turning the Power Control Knob (1) From Left to Right position. Then, to start turntable function, turn on the turn table function by step up Function Switch (14).
2. Set the speed control switch (5) to the correct speed of record you will be playing.
3. Place the record on the turntable, place the Slip mat before you place the record.
4. Lifting up the cue lever (8), move the tone arm (12) to the desired starting point on the record, then lower the tone arm (12). The record will start playing.
5. Adjust the volume control knob (1) to the desired sound level.

6. Slide the auto stop switch (6) to ON to operate the auto stop function.
7. At the end of the record, the tone arm (12) will stop automatically. You must return the tone arm to the tone arm holder manually.
8. When finished playing the turntable, please lock the tone arm holder (7) by gently pushing to the left and protect the needle by inserting the stylus guard.

Bluetooth Receiver Function (BT)

1. Press Step Down on the Function Switch (4) to start the Bluetooth Input function.
2. The Bluetooth indicator (4) flashes White while Bluetooth is beginning its search.
3. Activate the Bluetooth function on your Bluetooth device (see the device's user manual).
4. Select "DEAN" on your device for pairing.
5. After successful connection, the Bluetooth indicator LED (4) will turn to solid white.
6. Enjoy the music from your Bluetooth device (Make sure DEAN turntable is connected with his Bookshelf Speakers or any external Speaker via Out put Jacks).

Aux-In function (LINE-IN) (17)

1. Before use this AUX function, make sure the Function Switch is Step UP position as Turntable mode. This connection is especially useful in hooking up external devices to the Dean turntable and output with either external stereo speaker through his RCA line-out (15).
2. Hook one end of the 3.5 mm to the 3.5 mm mini-plug cable into Aux-in jack (17). (Please note that the turntable function will be immediately stopped when cable is connected) The other end will plug into the audio output jack of your device. (For more information on hooking up the external device, see the device user manual.)

OUTPUT

Line-out RCA (15)

Dual RCA to dual RCA cable - To connect the Dean turntable to Gadhouse Bookshelf speakers or any external speakers system, plug the red and white connectors on one end of the cable into the red and white line-out jack (15) on the back of the Dean turntable. The other end of the cable will plug into the stereo input jacks (RCA) of your selected component (see the component user manual).

Line-out 3.5mm (16)

1. To connect the Dean turntable to any external speakers (which uses a 3.5 mm), first of all connect the 3.5 mm mini-plug cable to Line-out 3.5mm jack (16) on the back of the Dean turntable. The other end of the cable will plug into Aux input jack (3.5 mm jack) of your selected component (see the component user manual).
2. To connect any earphones, headphones to DEAN turntable, first of all connect the 3.5 mm mini-plug cable of your selected device (see the component user manual) to Line-in 3.5mm jack (17) on the back of the Dean turntable.

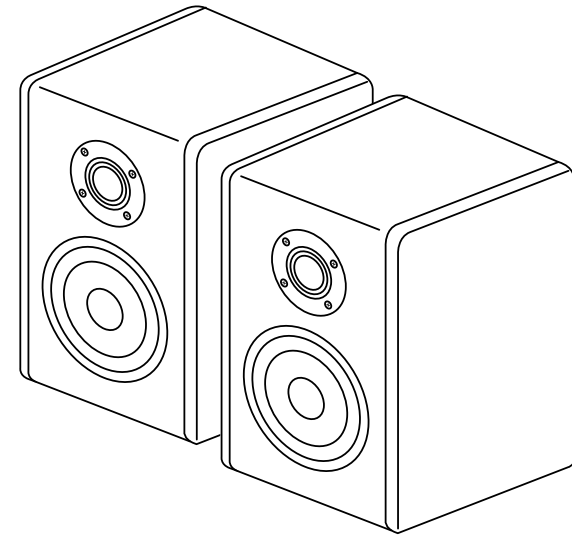

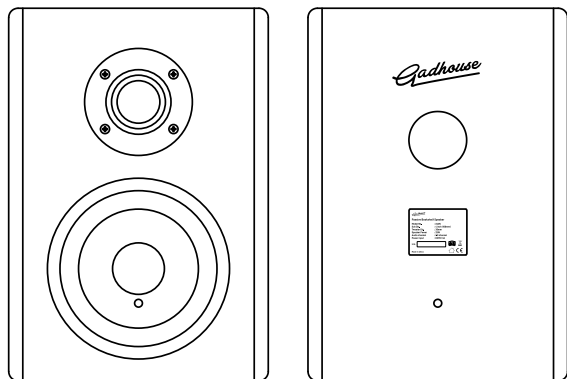

GETTING STARTED

Joan Bookshelf Speakers is passive-type. To connect to an input device, please make sure the speakers are equipped with an amplifier e.g. your turntable must be connected to a phono or an external amplifier before connecting to Joan Bookshelf Speakers.



Connecting the Turntable

To connect the turntable to Gadhouse Bookshelf Speakers, plug the speaker cable connectors into RCA out jacks on the back of the amplifier of the turntable. To see how to connect the speakers to a device e.g., turntable, please check our tutorial site; (www.gadhouse.com/tutorial)

RECOMMENDATIONS

GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

Height - To use Joan Bookshelf Speakers as stereo speakers from a fixed listening area, the Speakers should be located at the ear-level of a listener who is seated in the listening location.

Distance - It is recommended that the distance between each of the Joan Bookshelf Speakers be shorter than that from the speakers to a listener. For a perfect sound quality, both of the speakers should be tilted inward toward the listener.

Position - For the ultimate sound performance, the speakers should be situated in a vertical direction. If they are not in the ear-level of a listener i.e. much higher or lower than recommended, they can be put on their side for off-axis performance.

Amplifier Considerations

An amplifier should be well and carefully selected. The range of Joan Bookshelf Speakers' impedance is between 4 to 8 ohms. Thus, the amplifier chosen needs to be able to support a 4-ohm load. For an amplifier with a switch, it is required to set to select a 4-ohm compatible operation mode. If an amplifier is not selected or setup properly, the amplifier or the speakers can be damaged.

Amplifiers between 15 to 95 watts per channel can be used with the Joan Bookshelf Speakers along with good care. In case audible distortion occurs, it is suggested to turn the volume down until the distortion is gone. Likewise, when there is audible distortion, it is required that the speaker and amplifier not play for more than a few seconds.

Usage-Specific Recommendations

Bookshelf Speakers

To use the Joan Bookshelf Speakers as bookshelf speakers, the two speakers need to be at the same height as different heights of the speakers can result in degrading sounds quality. Try to place the speakers as close to the ear level as possible no matter the listening area is at a seated level or standing level.

Stereo Speaker on Stands

Likewise, please make sure that the speakers are positioned at the ear level of a listener when they are used with speaker stands. Therefore, speaker stands with a proper height should be used. To calculate the perfect ear level, measure the height of the listener's ear when seated in a listening area, then subtract 15 cm. For instance, if the listener's ear is 100 cm. from the floor when he/she sits, the appropriate height of speaker stands will be around 85 cm. high.

Desktop Near-field Monitor

In addition, the Joan Bookshelf Speakers can be used as desktop/near-field monitor speakers e.g., next to the side of a display or mixing console. However, the Joan Bookshelf Speakers should not be located close to CRT displays or other magnetic-sensitive equipment since they are not shielded. In case placing the Joan Bookshelf Speakers at the ear-level height is not possible, it is suggested to use Monitor Isolation Pads to tilt the speakers back or to decouple them from the desk level.
